Registration Requirements:

- Must present a government-issued, valid picture ID (Driver’s License, Passport, State ID) at the time of registration.
- Must bring your own blue or black ink pen
- Registration and Testing is required to begin classes
- Registration is in person; no virtual
- Must sign up by scanning the QR code or following the link
- Children may not be present for testing and registration or during classes
- *19 years of age or older (18 years old with an official withdrawal form public school and consent from your parent, 16 years old with a Court Order)
