

**San Jacinto College-South**  
**Associate of Arts (TWU Nursing Transfer Plan)**

**Texas Woman's University**  
**Bachelor of Science - Nursing Major**

This is a guaranteed course transfer agreement to Texas Woman's University for students who do not have a prior registered nursing license or degree and who are pursuing the nursing prerequisites (*TWU Nursing Transfer Plan*) at San Jacinto College-South in order to apply to the Bachelor of Science Degree with a major in nursing program at Texas Woman's University. In fulfilling TWU's prerequisites for the B.S. degree with a major in nursing, this plan will also give the student an Associate of Arts degree from San Jacinto College-South. TWU will transfer a maximum of 72 hours from San Jacinto College-South. The following courses to be taken through San Jacinto College-South will apply both to the A.A. degree and the B.S. degree unless otherwise indicated:

- b This course fulfills San Jacinto College-South associate degree sophomore literature requirements as well as one of TWU's Women's studies requirement.
- c May choose from PHIL 1311 or PHIL 1312 Introduction to Philosophy.
- d Choose from ARTS 1303, 1304; DANC 2303; DRAM 2361; MUSI 1308, or 1309. (Note: Also fulfills one of TWU's two Interdisciplinary course requirement.)
- e Choose from ANTH 2351, ENGL 2336, or PSYC 2370. (Note: Also fulfills one of TWU's two Interdisciplinary requirement.)

Consideration for admission to the TWU College of Nursing (Denton, Dallas, & Houston) requires a minimum 3.0 GPA and a minimum grade of C in microbiology and anatomy & physiology. Separate application must be made to the TWU Undergraduate Admission Office and to the TWU College of Nursing office by the appropriate deadlines. Acceptance to the university does not constitute automatic admission to the upper division of the College of Nursing. College of Nursing acceptance is on a competitive, space-available basis. Once admission to the College of Nursing is granted, the following upper division requirements must be fulfilled at TWU:




**Conditions of Student Transfer Contract**

1. This agreement applies to the Texas Woman's University catalog beginning 1997-1999. If a student completes the lower level prerequisites with a minimum 3.0 GPA, attains a minimum grade of C in microbiology and anatomy & physiology, and transfers to Texas Woman's University within two years of prerequisite completion, the student is eligible for this published articulation agreement. The lower level courses as listed will transfer to TWU and count fully toward the Bachelor of Science Degree with major in nursing requirements, if admitted to this program.
2. This agreement **DOES NOT** imply automatic acceptance to the TWU College of Nursing upper division. All other College of Nursing requirements must still be met. Admission to the College of Nursing is on a competitive, space-available basis.
3. This agreement means that the above San Jacinto College-South courses will transfer and that the Texas Woman's University B.S. with a major in nursing prerequisite requirements will not change for a student who transfers to TWU within two years of prerequisite completion. Only the courses on the current **TWU Nursing Transfer Plan** qualify for a student contract.
4. Written notification by TWU to San Jacinto College-South of prerequisite or program changes will automatically revise that portion of the San Jacinto College-South/TWU Nursing Transfer Plan without further action, and no further signatures will be necessary to effectuate the change. Thus this articulation agreement will be assumed to be current through revisions of the **San Jacinto College-South/TWU Nursing Transfer Plan**.


